The computers in the Homer and Ida B. Jones Creativity Center (JCC) are used specifically for educational, employment, and training purposes only. The public computers located in the Reference Department are for general Internet usage.

Before allowing computer usage, Library staff may check the student's standing with the BPL regarding any fines or reprimands.

Individuals not using JCC computers for their intended purposes will lose their status as a JCC student and will have to leave.

Friends, family, and children are only allowed to accompany students in the JCC computer lab under limited circumstances with special approval by JCC staff. The Children's Library is located on the 1st floor, and they offer computer/Internet access for ages 13 and under. Others are asked to wait outside the lab.

Those using the JCC will show respect for others at all times.

Those using the JCC will obey the Bristol Public Library Rules of Conduct and will abide by rules specific to the Homer and Ida B Jones Creativity Center.
